Dear TSCS Parents and Guardians,

Each year, the Tennessee Department of Education examines schools' performance across several indicators to provide an overall view of how schools are serving the needs of all students. The Department of Education included the following indicators in its analysis of school accountability: **Student achievement, Student growth, English learner proficiency exam (ELPA), Chronic absenteeism, Ready graduate and Graduation rate**. Under the federal Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA), the department is required to use the school accountability results to identify those schools with the lowest performance across student groups (e.g., individual racial/ ethnic student groups, students with disabilities, economically disadvantaged, and English learners).

We are writing to inform you that The Soulsville Charter School was identified for Comprehensive Support and Intervention (CSI) as required by ESSA and the U.S. Department of Education during the 2022/23 school year due to our Student achievement data. This federal designation will be retained until our school exits or a new designation list is released.

Our school continues to diligently with the district and the Tennessee Department of Education to increase student performance by...

1. Increasing the utilization, quality and frequency of formal and informal assessment data to guide instruction.
2. Review and improvement of assessments to better align with TNReady and EOC testing.
3. Implementation of additional support systems to enhance students' literacy and foundational skills.

We encourage you to help by participating in the development and implementation of our school improvement plan and by...

1. Ensuring that your student(s) attend school on-time every day and are prepared for learning.
2. Encouraging the development of a regular study routine to practice essential skills.
3. Ensuring that students attend tutoring and/or afterschool office hours when necessary.
